

Phonic reading

Hi, Mike! Mike, take a bike.

Ride a bike, Mike.

Mike, take a kite and a bike.



Phonic reading

- We can make cakes. We can make kites and ships.
- I'm Mike. I'm seven. I can swim.
- It's Kate. Kate's five. She can make cakes.
- It's Bill. He's ten. He can ride a bike.
- It's Tim. Tim's six. Tim can swim and ride a bike.

Mike can see three sweets and five cakes.


Jane can see a table and a bed.
